HIST TORY

1998

Handover

The house on Uang Raya Street No. 19 West Cilandak, South Jakarta was handed over to Indonesian Government through the Directorate General of Culture Directorate of Museums. It was later renovated to function as a museum.

2001

First Building Inauguration

On 25th September 2001, Basoeki Abdullah Museum was inaugurated by the Minister of Culture and Tourism, Drs. I Gede Ardika.

2006

Second Building Inauguration

On 29th November 2006, Building II of this Museum was inaugurated as a development museum by Prof. Dr. Muhadjir Effendy, MAP.
